Upground Reservoir Project

Minor Construction Activities planned in Hoskins Road & State Route 257 Area

Although the Phase 1 Raw Water Pipeline construction is not planned to begin until late spring 2010, residents will observe the following "construction activities" occurring in the vicinity of Hoskins Road and State Route 257 in March and April 2009.

- The Delaware County Engineer has scheduled the replacement of a storm culvert crossing Hoskins Road between State Route 257 and Mooney Road during the week of March 16-March 20, 2009. This work will closure of Hoskins Road while the culvert is replaced.
- The City of Columbus' consultant for the Upground Reservoirs will be performing additional soils investigations along a portion of the Phase 1 Raw Waterline route beginning March 30, 2009. Specifically Excavation equipment and field personnel will be working on City owned land on the north side of Hoskins Road and west of State Route 257. This work should be completed no later than May 1, 2009.
