Tree Removal at Reservoir Site 2

Beginning in **late February 2009**, a contractor will be cutting any trees on the Reservoir 2 site that must be removed before the reservoir contractor is selected and earthwork begins. The tree removal work is being done in advance of the reservoir work to allow these trees to be harvested for beneficial use. Additionally, a small number of standing or fallen trees will be removed within the with the Raw Water Pump Station construction limits that could potentially serve as habitat for the endangered Indiana Bat before the spring nesting season begins in accordance with regulatory requirements.

Weather permitting, it is anticipated that tree removal activities will be completed by the late spring of 2009.
